- Total Imported/Exported Eggs Should Not Exceed The Quantity Stipulated On The Permit;
- The Importer/exporter Should Report, On Expiry Of This Permit, On Actual Imports/Exports, And Present Invoices With The Report To The Department Of Marketing For Verification;
- This Permit Is Issued To Authorise. The Importer To Go Buy & Import, It Is Not Issued/Intended To Release Confiscated/Seized Eggs; &
- Responsibility Of Use Of This Permit Should Not Be Transferred To Suppliers.
- Other conditions:- Imported Eggs Should Not be Older Than Two Weeks &
- Imported Eggs Should Be Sold From Inside Of The Importer's Business Premises Specified on the permit;
