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# Agricultural Marketing (Distribution of Dairy Products) Regulations, 1992

# Agricultural Marketing (Distribution of Dairy Products) Regulations, 1992

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 4 of the Agricultural Marketing Act 1967, read with regulation 6 of the Lesotho National Dairy Board Regulations 1991

Major-General James Lebitso Dingiswayo

Minister of Agriculture make the following regulations:

#### Part I — Preliminary

Cidation and commencement 1. These regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Marketing (Distribution of Dairy Products) Regulations, 1992 and shall come into operation on the date of publication in the Gazette.

Interpretation

- 2. (1) In these regulations unless the context otherwise requires,
  - "Board" means the Lesotho National Dairy Board established under the Agricultural Marketing (Establishment of a Lesotho National Dairy Board) Regulations 1991;
  - "milk" has the same meaning assigned to it in the Agricultural Marketing (Establishment of a National Dairy Board) Regulations 1991;
  - "Minister" means the Minister responsible for Agriculture.
- (2) Words not specified defined in these regulations shall have the same meaning assigned to them in the Agricultural Marketing (Establishment of a National Dairy Board) Regulations 1991.

#### Part II - Permits

Permit to Deal in Dairy Products

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- 3. (1) Subject to regulation 8, all persons wishing to deal in, distribute, import or bring dairy products into Lesotho shall only do so when in possession of a permit issued by the Lesotho National Dairy Board.
- (2) Subject to regulation 8, a key of 2½% of the invoice value of any imported dairy products shall be charged on those imported dairy products.
- (3) No persons shall export or remove any dairy products from Lesotho unless he is authorised to do so under a permit issued by the Lesotho National Dairy Board.
- (4) The permit referred to in this regulation shall be as set out in the Second Schedule.

(1) Applications for permits referred to in regulation 3 shall be made in the form prescribed in the First Schedule and forwarded to the Lesotho National Dairy Board for consideration.

Application for a permit to deal in or distri/bute dairy products

- The Board, in considering the applications referred to in sub-regulation (1), shall take into account such factors as fitness for consumption, quality and adequacy of supply in Lesotho.
- (3) Applicants whose applications have been rejected by the Board shall be notified in writing.
- Any person who is dissatisfied with a decision of the Board in connection with any matter relating to his application for permit may, within 30 days of receiving the notification under sub-regulation (3), appeal to the Minister against the decision of the Board and the Minister may, after considering the appeal, confirm, set aside or vary the decision, as he may deem fit The decision of the Minister shall be final.
- (1) A person issued with a permit under regulation 3 shall.

Monthly Returns and

- (a) submit his invoices or copies thereof to the Board within 10 days after the end of each calendar month;
- (b) submit a monthly return of his import and export quantities and buying and selling prices.
- (2) Any fees payable in respect of a permit issued under these regulations shall be paid into the funds of the Board.
- (3) Any person who fails to comply with the requirements of sub-regulation (1) commits an offence and on conviction, in addition to any other penalty the court may impose, his permit

## Part III - Offences and Penalties

(1) Any illegally-imported dairy products shall be confiscicated by a customs officer in accordance with the Customs and Excise Act 1982.

Confiscation and seizure

- Any illegally imported dairy products may be seized by an officer charged with carrying out inspectorate work in traders' shops or wholesalers' stores.
- 7. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with Penalties these regulations shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction shall be liable to a fine not exceeding M400 or to imprisonment for 6 months or both; and on a second or subsequent conviction to a fine not exceeding M2003or imprisonment for 2 years or both.

2000 These regulations shall not apply to the dairy products Exemptions listed in the Third Schedule.

Repeals

 $9.\,$  The Agricultural Marketing (Milk Control) Regulations  $1988^5$  are repealed.
