

VETERINARY HEALTH ATTESTATION FOR FISH

Lesotho Permit Number

I, _____, the undersigned veterinarian/official authorized by the Director of Veterinary Services in South Africa attest to the following;

f) The fish originate from a zone, which has been recognized to be free from epizootic haematopoietic necrosis, infectious pancreatic necrosis, oncorhynchus masou virus disease, Bacterial kidney disease and viral haemorrhagic septicaemia;

g) The fish must not in any way be handled so as to allow the transmission of any infectious of contagious disease;

h) The fish must be transported in containers, which are constructed in such a way so as to prevent the contamination of the fish by disease causing agents and equipment with a thermograph;

i) The fish must be loaded and sealed by authorized officials and the seal number must be indicated on the international veterinary certificate;
