

VETERINARY HEALTH ATTESTATION FOR LIVE ANIMALS

Lesotho Permit Number.....

I, _____, the undersigned veterinarian/official authorized by the Director of Veterinary Services in South Africa attest to the following;

6. Animals are of South African origin;
7. Originate from an area or zone which is FMD free and the area is not under any veterinary restrictions for diseases to which the species are susceptible ;
8. The animals were inspected 21 days before export by an authorized veterinary official and are clinically healthy, free of obvious external parasites and fit to travel;
9. Animals are branded or tattooed as prescribed.
10. In case of sheep the animals are visibly free of sheep scab and have been treated with a remedy registered against sheep scab before export. The importer has been informed about the withdrawal period of this remedy. Note.: The consignment meant for slaughter is exempt, but limited to 10 animals only per consignment;
11. The animals were, in case of cattle vaccinated against anthrax at least 2 weeks but not more than 12 months before export to Lesotho;
12. In case of ruminants:
 - a) showed no evidence of Rift Valley Fever on the day of shipment.
 - b) were vaccinated against Rift Valley Fever at least 21 days prior to shipment with modified live virus vaccine under veterinary supervision.
 - c) Were held in quarantine for at least 30 days prior to shipment during which the animals showed no clinical signs of Rift Valley Fever.
13. In case of dairy cows/dairy goats, the must have been tested for brucellosis and tuberculosis and found negative in the preceding 6 months to export to Lesotho. Have been quarantined 30 days prior to export to Lesotho;
14. In case of pigs:
 - a. have not been vaccinated against CSF nor are they progeny of a vaccinated sow.
 - b. Originate from an area not under veterinary restrictions for diseases which the species is susceptible;
 - c. were examined 7 days prior to export and found healthy, free of external and internal parasites and are fit to travel;
 - d. Treated with registered remedies for internal and external parasites, and importer has been informed of the withdrawal period;
15. The exporter/importer has been informed to undertake to inform the government veterinary officials nearest to the point of destination, so that they could check the consignment on arrival;
16. This permit is valid for only one consignment and quantity indicated overleaf.
